New! Dheinsville Walking Tour Sign



Self-Guided Walking Tour sign located on the West side of the Wolf Haus, parking available near sign to stop.

In honor of Founder's Day, August 22nd, our new Dheinsville Settlement Walking Tour Sign was installed just west of the Wolf Haus. There is an area there to pull up and park to view the sign! The first afternoon over 20 visitors stopped by to view it. The existing Dheinsville Park sign was moved to the fence on Holy Hill Road as our park does not have an official village park sign. This aids residents in finding us.

We are currently updating our walking tour brochure and contacting the homes on the walking tour to see if they would like to be part of this history either by small numbers on a stake or on their home designating their historical property.

Funding for signage was approved through the Village of Germantown Tourism/Betterment Fund. The next phase is to get Museum directional signage within the Village which we desperately need. Visitors cannot find us.

Lammscapes will be installing a brick planter and plantings at the base of the sign.

NEW BENCHES AND PATHS

Boy Scout Troop 67 of Germantown, under direction of the Eagle Scout Michael Ellis, are working this summer on an improvement project in Dheinsville Park.

Three phases of work include weeding/spraying and clean-up of ground paths between the three buildings. A new cover of gravel has been added and provided a more solid, cleaner pathway for visitors, tour groups, seniors and school children in the park. That work was completed on July 11 and 12th.

The third phase includes the construction of "Leopold/Ice Age" benches to be placed along the pathways. Assembly will be performed by scouts, family and friends of Troop 67 at the end of August under the direction of Michael Ellis. Fundraising for materials continues and is appreciated by the crew. 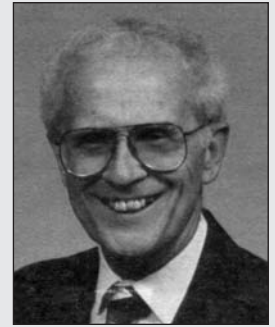
